# Criteria For Nomination

## Significant Contributors:

- 1.) Individuals who have made a difference in and positively impacted multiple generations of students.
- 2.) Should have contributed to the school's growth and success, benefiting the community in various ways.
- 3.) Examples include educators, administrators, supporters, and community members who have gone above and beyond to enrich the school experience.
- 4.) Their contributions should align with the school's values and have left a legacy that continues to positively influence the school environment.
- 5.) Those who have actively engaged with the school for a minimum of 25 years will be considered.
- 6.) If employed by school they must be retired or absent from school affiliation for 3 years before consideration.

## Coaches:

- 1.) Coaches should have significantly impacted the lives of their athletes by fostering personal growth, discipline, and leadership skills.
- 2.) Demonstrated a record of success through high winning percentages and state championships.
- 3.) Served as positive role models and mentors, contributing to the holistic development of student-athletes.
- 4.) A minimum of ten years of head coaching experience at Sabetha high school.
- 5.) Is eligible for nomination after 5 years after retirement

## Athletes:

- 1.) Must have received highest honors in their respective sports
- 2.) Should have consistently demonstrated exceptional skill, leadership, and sportsmanship throughout their athletic career.
- 3.) A record of consistent performance and dedication to their sport.
- 4.) Graduated from high school at least ten years prior to being nominated.
- 5.) Athletes that participated in individual sports without highest honors should have won multiple state championships in their respective sport.
- 6.) In addition, nominees who have gone on to professional sports careers and have made a significant impact in their respective fields will receive special consideration, as their achievements further exemplify the excellence fostered at Sabetha High School.

## Lifetime Achievement

- 1.) Graduates of Sabetha High School who have consistently exemplified the core values of the institution and have graduated from Sabetha High School, will be up for nomination 10 years after graduation.
- 2.) Must have extended their positive influence beyond the school, significantly impacting the lives of individuals and communities in society.
- 3.) Their achievements and contributions should align with the school's values and have a transformative effect on society, fostering positive change and enhancing the well-being of others.

## Induction Process

### Criteria

- 1.) Nominees must exemplify the highest standards of the beliefs and values of Sabetha High School. They must have demonstrated outstanding and exceptional abilities in the category for which they are nominated
- 2.) Nominees must meet the criteria for the area of nomination
- 3.) All nominees will be judged on their significant and long-term impact and contributions to Sabetha or representing Sabetha in their respective community.
- 4.) An individual may not nominate himself/herself

### Time Limitation

- 1.) A nominee will be considered for two (2) consecutive years. If a nominee is not selected during that period, the nominee will be placed in the "inactive" file. "Inactive" indicates that the nominee is no longer considered for Hall of Fame induction until renominated. A three (3) year waiting period is required before renomination.

### Number of inductees

- 1.) There will be an inaugural class of up to 6 inducted in the Hall of Fame, followed by a 2nd class of up to 6 inductees.
- 2.) Each year after the inaugural classes, there will be 2 inducted in the Hall of Fame

Any changes to the criteria will be made in accordance with the evolving needs and standards of our school community.**
