VB Tournament Rules & Regulations

1. Regular High School Volleyball Rules:
 - a. Exceptions:
 - a. Must have at least 1 male on the court at all times
 - b. Net will be set at approx. 8 feet
 - c. If male contacts the ball, and there is more than 1 contact, a female must also contact it.
2. Each team is responsible for officiating games as scheduled.
 - a. Team is responsible for 2 officials, 2 line judges, and 2 score clock personnel
 - b. If your team prefers not to officiate, you may donate \$100 and the FCCLA members will officiate.
3. Must be at least a HS freshman to participate
4. Waivers will be signed and money will be paid prior to your first game
5. Volleyballs will be provided
6. Number of games and format of tournament will be set dependent on number of teams participating. Minimum of 3 games per team.
