SAEBERS Screener Social Emotional Learning

As part of our revised MTSS process our district will be giving a Social Emotional/Behavior Screener starting in the fall called SAEBERS. SAEBRS is a brief tool supported by research for use in universal screening for behavioral and emotional risk. The measure falls within a broad class of highly efficient tools, suitable for teacher use in evaluating and rating all students on common behavioral criteria (Severson, Walker, Hope-Doolittle, Kratochwill, & Gresham, 2007). The SAEBRS is designed for use in the K-12 setting. It is grounded within a conceptual model, which states that a student's success in school is not only related to his or her academic achievement, but also success within multiple behavioral domains. This will serve as one of the Outcomes for Measuring Progress as required by the state in the KESA process for measuring social/emotional growth.

Additionally, we will be implementing social/emotional learning as part of our curriculum for the 2017-18 school year. At the elementary level (PreK-5), we have purchased the Second Step program. Teachers will teach a brief 30 minute lesson weekly and reinforce the concepts throughout the week. We will also be implementing the Bullying Prevention program incorporated with Second Step. At the middle and high school level we will be utilizing the College and Career Competency Framework as our curriculum model for social emotional learning. We are in the process of arranging this training for the fall of 2017 to begin implementation in the spring of 2018.
