At-Risk Preschool Application Deadline: SES has recently held its screening for applicants for the 2019-20 school year. Twenty one applications were turned in prior to the screening date of March 1. Eleven of those applicants qualified automatically per eligibility requirements, which left ten applicants to screen. An additional six students qualified through the screening process. Currently we have 17 of our 24 slots filled. We expect we will receive additional applications prior to the start of school that will result in additional screenings.
