### Field Trips:

#### **MTSS Implementation:**

• The spring screening window for Fastbridge assessments will conclude on May 10<sup>th</sup>. Students will complete screeners in the areas of reading and math. Teachers will complete the SAEBRS screener as well. This information will help us to review student progress and determine areas in which particular attention needs to be given. **Music Programs**: Kindergarten performed their first elementary program on Thursday, April 25<sup>th</sup> at 12:45 pm and 7:00 pm. Our music program schedule for the 2018-19 school year concluded with a spring vocal and instrumental concert for 5<sup>th</sup> grade students. This program was held Friday, May 3rd at 7:00 pm. Mrs. McGill and Mrs. Topp are to be commended for their work in preparing students for this performance as it was very entertaining.

5<sup>th</sup> Grade Transition Meeting: 5<sup>th</sup> grade students and parents attended a transition meeting at Sabetha Middle School on April 24<sup>th</sup>. Mrs. Dana Michael, SES/SMS counselor, and Principal Garber organized a program that communicated important information regarding future enrollment at the middle school. Topics included: curriculum bell schedules, technology usage, IPS program, social activities, etc. Students also spent time on this day observing the middle school environment. This included eating lunch in the building, hearing from Brook Brubeck about meal options, touring the building, viewing the locker rooms and completing a scavenger hunt.

**2018 Field Day**: SES is scheduled to hold our Field Day on Friday, May 10<sup>th</sup>. Each student K-5 will participate in 4 different activities: a running event, a field event, a group game, and a fun relay station.
