JDDC Bullying (See EBC, GAAE, JCE, JDD, JGEC, JGECA, and KGC) JDDC

The board of education prohibits bullying in any form by any student,

staff member, or parent towards a student or a staff member on or while using

school property, in a school vehicle, or at a school-sponsored activity or event.

For the purposes of this policy, the term "bullying" shall have the meaning

ascribed to it in Kansas law.

The administration shall propose, and the board shall review and

approve a plan to address bullying as prohibited herein. The plan shall include

provisions for the training and education of staff members and students and

shall include appropriate community involvement as approved by the board.

Students who have bullied others in violation of this policy may be

subject to disciplinary action, up to and including suspension and/or expulsion.

If appropriate, students who violate the bullying prohibition shall be reported to

local law enforcement.

PROCEDURES FOR ADMINISTERING THE ANTI-BULLYING

- 1. USD 113 will integrate anti-bullying into the Positive Behavior Support.
 - a. Each staff member will be review the Positive Behavior Support plan for the building. .
 - b. Each building will conduct training sessions with students dealing with procedures and character-building activities of the PBS.
 - c. Building Site Councils will review the PBS and have an opportunity for input.
 - d. All guidelines will be in effect at school, school activities, or in school-owned vehicles.
 - e. Each building will list, in their respective handbooks, the positive behavior support plan.
