Building

- As a building, we are working hard on the Equipping Resiliency training.
- Leo continues to advance with his therapy dog training.
- We have two new staff members that have joined our team. Jessica Fulton as a part-time custodian and Jenny Lierz as a full-time Instructional Support Staff. Both are great additions to our staff.

Students/Activities

- KAYs club raised over \$700 dollars for the food pantry. They also did Halloween classroom parties for the grade school students.
- STUCO sponsored the annual Veteran's Day Program
- The boys' cross-country team got 4th at state. Grady Buessing got 14th.
- This year the library is sponsoring a bookmark/keychain reading incentive. For every book a student reads, they earn a punch on their punch card. After 10 punches, they are able to come to the library to make a bookmark or keychain. No district funds were used for this incentive.
- The library candy gram sales start this month. All the money used to purchase books and supplies for the library comes from candy grams sales, Best Choice Labels money, and our booster club. At Christmas, staff, students, and patrons may purchase a candy cane with a note for a student. The library has a secret Santa who ensures every student receives a candy gram. They also sell candy grams for Valentine's Day. The library usually makes around \$900 a year.
- The 1st graders have a mystery guest reader in their class every week!
- The 2nd graders have been incorporating lots of songs and movement into their lessons. The students are up dancing, walking, singing, and stretching. They never have to sit for long periods. Their November art projects will be displayed in the Axtell Post Office this month. This school year, they have also read and passed quizzes on over 290 books!
- The 3rd graders have had a lot of fun learning about magnets and forces, they held a mock election, and have solved over 25,000 math facts on Reflex!
