Beanstack Reading Program: We have started a new reading program called Beanstack. It allows students to scan their books to track what they are reading and how long they have read, either on their iPad at school or a cell phone at home. Every student from PreK to 5th grade can participate, as the minutes that are read to the students also count. Once a student finishes a book, the program gives them a choice of how to show their summary. They can draw something, build something, or write something. It's up to them. We had a launch assembly with all the students on Friday, November 4. Soon, we will send out a tutorial video to parents. We will have challenges between classes, grades, and, hopefully, other schools. We are setting a goal for our school of 600,000 minutes read by the end of the school year. If we make our goal, I will let the students vote to choose an activity that I have to do at a final party in May. I'll keep you posted on our progress.

**Family Fun Night:** We had our "Wizard of Oz" Family Fun night on Thursday, November 3rd, from 5-7 pm. Parents and families followed the Yellow Brick Road throughout SES to answer Grade-level math and reading questions. We had about 125 students and a total of about 250 people participate.
