Re: June BOE Meeting Building Report

- 1. Year End Events: Our students and staff were able to participate in incentive activities at Sycamore Springs. School lunches were transported to Sycamore Springs. Students were allowed to choose from various activities. Students enjoyed themselves and were in good behavior!
- 2. Summer Building Activities: Summer school for our SES and SMS students has started and is going well. Summer Girls Basketball league uses our building on Tuesday evenings. The SHS Drama Camp is scheduled for the last week in June.
- 3. Building Maintenance: Dean Strathman and Jeffrey Mann have gotten off to a good start with our summer projects. Also, our gym floor has been re-finished, which is early than we have done in the past. Note: Dean will be out for an extended time due to shoulder surgery.
- 4. Facilities: We have continued to monitor the repaired roof on the gym and have had several additional service calls. Our new high definition projector has been installed in the auditorium and is a nice and needed improvement!
- 5. **Staffing:** We are currently still needing to hire staff for our 6th grade ELA courses. It is a work in progress.

- 6. Summer Meetings/Trainings: We held our year end BLT meeting on May 25th. We discussed our new accreditation cycle with possible district goals and building goals. As a building, we also reviewed our State Assessment scores, FastBridge scores, MTSS program, class schedule, behavior data, social emotional data, tentative plans for the start of next school year, new student technology considerations and adjustments with our new staff members, etc. We will meet later this summer as well.
- 7. Resiliency Training: On June 7th I attended an Administrator Resiliency training aimed at making our school trauma responsive. I appreciated the content and am interested to continue discussions with Heather Schremmer and Dana Michael, who are attending Resiliency Coach training, as to the impact this can have in our building and with our students.
