Navigating Change: We continue to prepare for protocols and measures to comply with the Navigating Change guidelines and keep students, staff, parents and community members safe. Sanitizer and sanitizer refills continues to arrive. Thermometers for temperature checks have arrived and are in the office. Additional masks, sanitizer stations and other PPE have been ordered. All adults and students in grades 5-12 are required to wear masks inside the school building and practice social distancing. Teachers are working to plan for the set-up of classrooms and content delivery. Our Building Leadership Team continues to meet to address operational concerns as we prepare for students in the building.
