MTSS: Grade level groups met at the last PLC (Professional Learning Community) and determined needed Tier support in Reading and Math and formed intervention groups. Interventions are in place and teachers and instructional staff are implementing progress monitoring of these groups. During PLC meetings, teachers and instructional staff continue to look at progress monitoring data. We are starting to



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look deeper into our behavioral/social emotional data to determine needed individual support in the area of social-emotional learning. We have been teaching Career Competency lessons throughout the high school classes and Second Step lessons in grades K-8 to support our efforts in the area of behavior/social emotional learning. We continue to address the district and school improvement process, KESA-Cycle 2. We have finalized our building goals and are currently discussing strategy implementation. I would like to thank the BLT, teachers, instructional staff, and Mrs. Gatz for their diligent work to help prepare us for implementation.

Advisory: Grades 6-12 Advisory is underway and the focus is on Individual Plans of Study using Xello as the product. We meet once a month to complete the grade level activities. November lessons focus on career symposium preparation and ongoing updates with Eportfolios, goals, plans, and experiences.
