

Driver's Education

- Driver's Education will start the Tuesday after Memorial Day. Class and range are generally 7-8 days long. Road driving is usually finished by the end of June.
- Encourage your student to study for and pass the test to earn his/her instructional permit (obtained at your local DMV office) when he/she turns 14... Any driving experience a student has prior to starting driver's education helps to lessen the difficulties and anxieties of the class.
- To any student who emails Ms. Castillo a request, she will provide a digital copy of the DMV Kansas Drivers' Handbook study guide.
- The class is competency based.....students must successfully pass the classroom (all tests, including a Kansas Drivers' Handbook test), range driving (maneuvers in the SHS parking lot) and road driving with an 80% or better in order to pass the class. There are only three opportunities to pass each test, so helping your student study for the test and practice the road maneuvers benefits them greatly.
