**Minutes of the Special BOE Meeting, Wednesday, October 13, 2021 12:00 noon**  
**Held at Board of Education office, 1619 South Old Hwy 75, Sabetha, KS**

Board President Leslie Scoby called the meeting to order at 12:00 noon. President Scoby led the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and silent prayer. Board members present were Ann Shaughnessy, Jim Scoby, and Ed Reznicek, with Kathy Lippert and Stan Keim attending by ZOOM. Also in attendance were Superintendent Todd Evans, Board Clerk Deb Damman, and others listed on the attached sign-in sheet. The meeting was broadcast on ZOOM for the public.

The purpose of the meeting was to re-visit the Marshall County Test-to-Learn, Test-to-Play option, and to enter into Executive Session to discuss personnel matters for non-elected personnel.

Kent Saylor joined the meeting at 12:01 p.m.

President Scoby announced that Waiver of Notice for the meeting was signed by the Board members present. Stan Keim and Kathy Lippert, who attended by ZOOM, verbally approved signature of waiver at 12:04 p.m. The waiver is attached to these minutes.

The Board discussed the pros and cons of the Marshall County Health Department COVID-19 Quarantine Protocol for Axtell Public Schools.

Kathy Lippert moved to not accept Marshall County's Test-to-Stay/Test-to Play in any USD 113 building. There was no second and motion was withdrawn.

Motion was made by Ed Reznicek, seconded by Kent Saylor, to adopt the Marshall County Test-to-Stay/Test-to-Play testing protocol for Axtell only. After discussion, the motion was defeated by a 4-3 vote with Kathy Lippert, Stan Keim, Jim Scoby, and Leslie Scoby voting no. Ann Shaughnessy, Ed Reznicek, and Kent Saylor voted yes.

At 1:02 p.m, motion was made by Jim Scoby, seconded by Kent Saylor, to enter into executive session to discuss personnel matters for non-elected personnel as allowed under KOMA for 8 minutes until 1:10 p.m. with Mr. Evans. Motion carried 7-0.

At 1:10 p.m., motion was made by Jim Scoby, seconded by Kent Saylor, to return to regular session. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion was made by Ed Reznicek, seconded by Kent Saylor, to accept the resignation of Loduska Drew with liquidated damages. Motion carried 7-0.

At 1:11 p.m., motion was made by Kent Saylor, seconded by Kathy Lippert, to adjourn. Motion carried 7-0.
